



TENNIS RULES



1. Only NSSC members, and guests accompanied by a member, are authorized to use the courts. *Prior to play*, please present your gate control card to the front desk.
2. The rules and regulations regarding conduct, as set forth by the NSSC, also apply to tennis court use. Also, please observe *Friend at Court* etiquette.
3. All players must wear rubber-soled tennis or basketball shoes.
4. Only tennis will be played on the courts. No unauthorized activities are allowed on the tennis court.
5. Only beverages in nonbreakable containers are allowed on the tennis court.
6. Any NSSC-sanctioned events that may cause the courts to become unavailable will be posted in advance on the Tennis Court Bulletin Board.
7. Players must close the gate upon entering and leaving the tennis courts. The gate must be closed during play.
8. When players are waiting, the time of play is 1 hour for singles and 1½ hours for doubles, at which point the court will be surrendered to the waiting players.
9. Players are responsible for removing all debris from the tennis courts (tennis ball cans, sticks, leaves, etc.). Please leave the court cleaner than when you arrived.
10. Play takes precedence over individual practice. A player without a partner will surrender the court to two waiting players.
11. Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult.
12. The tennis court hours of play follow the swim club hours during the summer swim season (May 28 through September 4)—At closing, the guards will ask you to leave the premises; All other times the courts close at 9 p.m.

RESERVATION RULES

Due to the increase in the desire for court time in the warmer months it is necessary to institute a reservation system.

1. Court reservations can be made during the months when the swimming pool is open.
2. Reservations must be made at least one day in advance by signing up on a Reservation Sheet located at the Pool sign-in booth. Reservation sheets for the current day will be posted on the Tennis Court Bulletin Board.
3. Reservations will be made using the shareowner name and membership number in the applicable spaces. Member will present gate card to prove reservation.
4. Members may not reserve the court more than 1 hour per day for singles or 1½ hours for doubles play.
5. If the players do not arrive within ten minutes after the reserved time their reservation will be forfeited.
6. During the months when the pool is not open no reservation system will be available and play will be on a first come, first serve basis.
